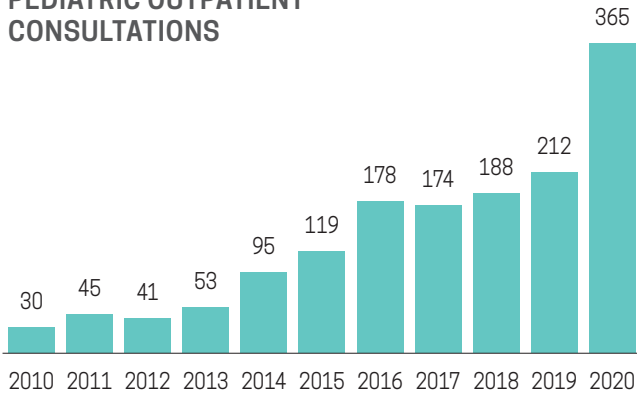

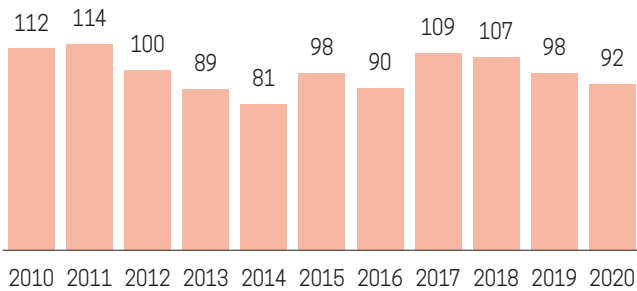

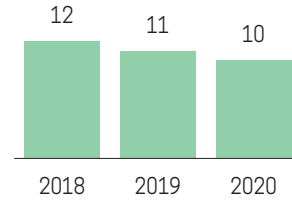


NUMBER OF CHILDREN HOSPITALIZED

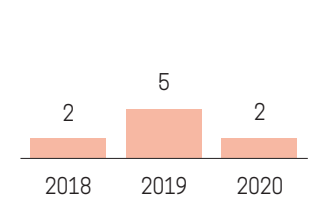


PEDIATRIC HEPATOBILIARY OPERATIONS

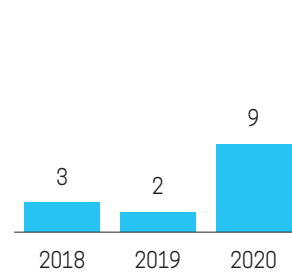

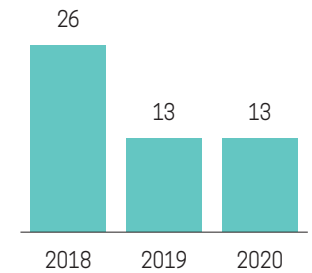

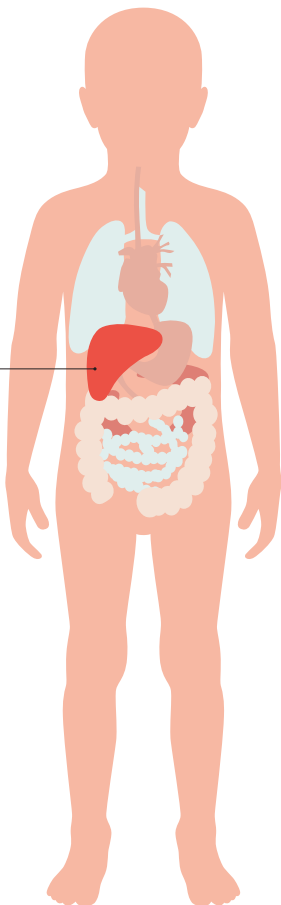

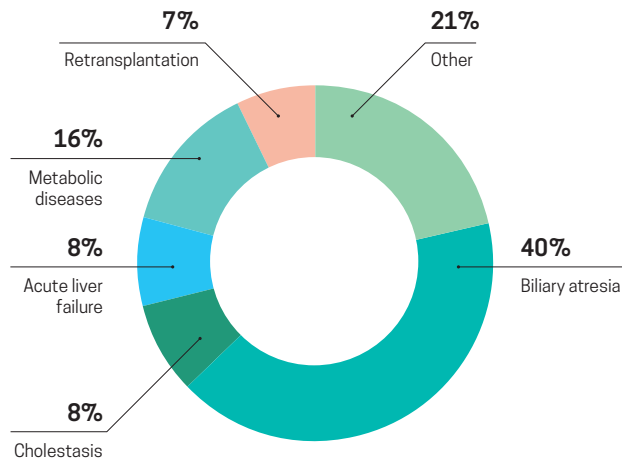

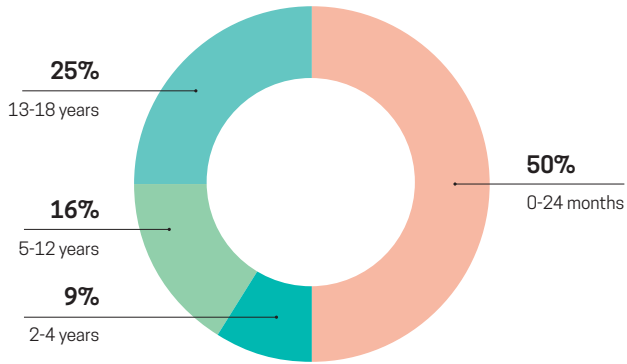


INDICATIONS FOR PEDIATRIC LIVER TRANSPLANTS 2007-2020

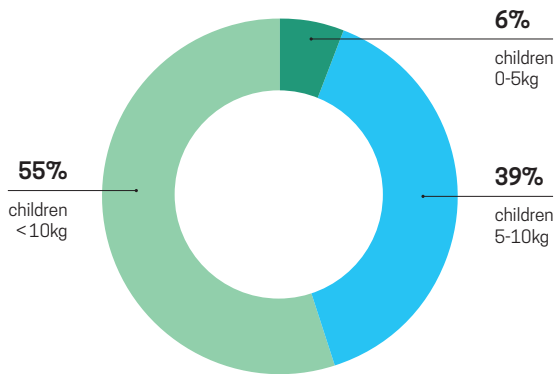

AGE AT TRANSPLANT 2018-2020

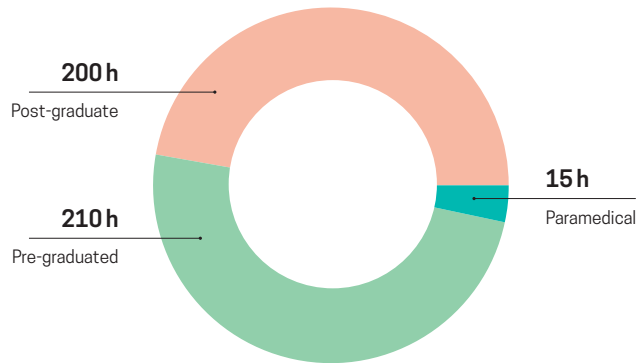


NUMBER OF TRANSPLANTATIONS BY WEIGHT CATEGORY 2018-2020

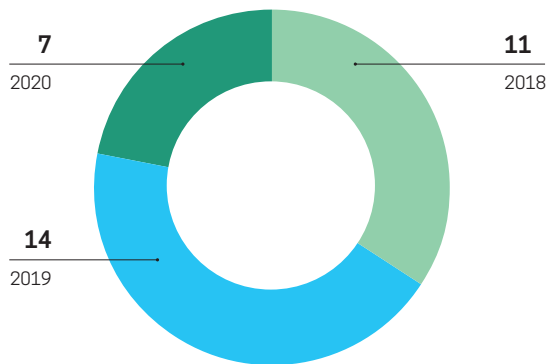
